Materials:

Chocolate Chip cardstock 4 ¼ x 11

More Mustard cardstock 4 x 5 ¼

Really Rust cardstock 3 ¾ x 5

Whisper White Top Note Die

Chocolate Chip Ribbon 15"

Really Rust cardstock scrap

Post it Note

Horizontal Slot Punch

Key Tag Punch

1 ¾ Circle Punch

Dimensionals

1. To make this beautiful sunset card first punch a circle out of a Post it Note using a 1 ¾ circle punch. You can use smaller circle punches if needed.
2. Using More Mustard ink, brayer the ink lightly over the Top Note Die Cut. Place your Punched Post it Note Circle onto the Top Note towards the top of your die cut. Brayer over the entire Top Note die and your mask using Pumpkin Pie Ink. Brayer your cardstock until you get the desired color.
3. Stamp the flower silhouette using Chocolate Chip ink onto the bottom of the Top Note. Using the Horizontal Slot punch, punch a small slit onto the left of the Top Note. Using 15" of Chocolate Chip ribbon tie this under the Top Note Die and around Really Rust cardstock in a square knot. Carefully place dimensionals on Top Note Die to adhere onto the Really Rust cardstock. Adhere this onto More Mustard cardstock and Chocolate Chip cardstock.
4. Stamp Thank You onto Really Rust cardstock using Chocolate Chip ink and punch using the Key Tag Punch.
5. Adhere under the sunset using dimensionals.
